






Welcome to Peru

Located at the confluence of the valleys of the Chillón, Rímac and Lurín rivers, it is part of Metropolitan Lima, enriched by its diverse landscape that includes the coastal desert. At an altitude of approximately 150 meters above sea level, its strategic position in the center of the Peruvian coast distinguishes it. With a rich history that dates back to pre-Columbian cultures and Inca influence, Lima stands out for its historical sites, its varied gastronomy and its popular artistic expressions, such as ceramics and handicrafts. 








Venue of the Event




